## Signs of Safety Leaders' Day

Forging organisations that support the practice Thursday 22 October

Practictioners have been contributing to the evolution of the Signs of Safety approach for over 25 years. While the approach makes sense to social workers and they want to use it, the biggest challenge to actually applying the Signs of Safety in practice lies in transforming the compliance driven culture and operations of their child protection organisations to align with participatory practice. This is simple to say but so very hard to achieve. Organisational change depends on determined, courageous and intelligent whole system leadership. Over the past 12 years, large scale implementations of the Signs of Safety have been undertaken across the world. Working together with these agencies and their leaders we have distilled the lessons of this international effort into a clear, whole system framework for organisational implementation. In this Leaders' Day, presenters will share their experience in Signs of Safety implementation.

This will be a unique learning opportunity for children's services leaders to come together in Calgary with international colleagues to share experiences and draw inspiration from the presenters to strengthen our efforts to forge organisations that can support participatory Signs of Safety practice.
